Match Officials:

<u>Squads:</u>	As per squadding list and times.
Local Club Rules:	No live firing is allowed to take place outside any unbaffled areas.
Scoring Area:	Competitors are not permitted in this area and is completely out of bounds. No exceptions will be allowed.
<u>Catering:</u>	Meals will be available on the range from Friday morning through to Sunday afternoon.

ICORE Rules:

The match will be conducted under the current ICORE Rulebook. The current edition of the rulebook can be downloaded from the ICORE site at <u>www.icore.org/rulebook.html</u>

Compliance requirements:

- A current holster proficiency: holster qualification card or equivalent will need to be sited.
- Eye and ear protection will be required on all ranges.
- You will need ample speed loaders or moon clips
- Your holster, ammunition holders and belt will need to meet ICORE Regulations
- Your revolver must meet the requirements for Open. Limited, Limited 6 or Classic Division
- Your loaded ammunition used must meet or exceed 120,000 power factor

On arrival at the Bendigo Pistol Club Complex:

- Proceed to the Sign In area. You will need to have your Holster proficiency qualification available for sighting and division compliance.
- Check squadding information.
- It is each competitor's responsibility to sign in each day on the correct Accreditation Forms.
- Collect your match bag which will include your score sheets and t-shirt.
- Check that you are entered in the correct grade and special recognition category

Protests:

All protests will be processed according to the current ICORE Rulebook

"Competitor protests regarding scoring and/or Range Officer's decisions must be made verbally, first to the Range Officer in charge of the stage, then to the Range Master* or Match Director. If no consensus can be reached, a written protest along with a protest fee of double the normal match fee or \$100, whichever is less, must be submitted to the Match Director within one hour of the verbal protest. The Match Director will choose an Arbitration Committee. It will consist of one Match Official and two competitors. The Match Director, Range Master*, and the involved Range Officer cannot be on the Arbitration Committee. The Committee's decision must be made before final match scores are posted. The Committee's decision must be in writing and is final. If the protester prevails, the fee is refunded, if not, the Match Director keeps the fee. All written protests and written decisions, whether won or lost, should be sent to the rule's director within 60 days."

If a shooter has a protest, they <u>are not to sign the score sheet</u>. If the Match Director or Chief Range Officer are in the process of competing, they are not to be contacted until after they have completed the stage, they are competing in.

The protest fee for the ICORE 20th Regional Revolver Championship 2022 has been set at AUD\$100 (one hundred Australian dollars). Protest fees are to be lodged **in cash** with the Match Director. ***For this match the Range Master will be the Chief Range Officer.**

Chronograph:

Competitors' ammunition must meet the minimum power factor as described in the current ICORE Rulebook

Safety Areas:

For the period of the competition, 7th to 9th October 2022 the following will apply:


A Safety area is clearly marked and located on all ranges. <u>No ammunition (including</u> <u>dummy rounds and snap caps) are to be handled in the safety area. Handling of</u> <u>ammunition in the safety area will result in match disqualification.</u>

Guns may be holstered or bagged in the safety area. Guns may also be holstered or bagged on the firing line **under the direction of the Range Officer.** Guns may be cleaned and checked in the safety area. Guns must not be handled in any other area of the shooting complex.

Dry firing may be undertaken in the safety area.

Practice drawing may be undertaken in the safety area.

Holstered guns may be taken to all areas within the Bendigo Pistol Club complex.
